To me In my opinion, (<-- 'To me' is too informal.) this could be beneficial for individuals but might be harmful to society as a whole.

Receiving accurate information of about (<-- 'Of' doesn't fit here.) emergencies and problems could give help warn individuals and enable them to prepare themselves, warnings, (<-- This wasn't specific enough.) For instance, information including regarding (<--'Regarding' fits better here.) environmental problems such as air pollution is vital to pass on to the public through the (<-- You need this word - 'the media' collectively refers to television, newspapers, and other forms of disseminating information.) media. Without such information, people might keep polluting the environment until there is no solution and the world would become becomes (<-- The tense wasn't quite correct here. You said 'there is' earlier in the sentence, which is the present tense - you need to continue to use this.) unlivable uninhabitable. (<-- 'Uninhabitable' fits better here because it means people can't live in a certain place, rather than that they just can't live.) Besides In addition, (<-- 'Besides' is an informal term. You shouldn't use it in academic work.) delivering important emergency warnings in time could save people's lives. For example, in China, thousands of people were (<-- You need this word.) evacuated in time before the a flood hit came (<-- This sentence wasn't quite correct.) in June 1998 merely because ty televisions (<-- 'TV' needs to be capitalised. However, this is formal writing, so it's better to say 'televisions'.) and radios broadcasted the emergency warning the night before the flooding. Therefore, delivering information with (<-- You need this word. The sentence is incorrect without it.) regards to issues and emergencies is beneficial to individuals.

However, the media's overly focus over-focus (<-- This was quite awkward.) on problems and emergencies could lead to panic and chaos in society. There is a board broad (<-- 'Board' has several meanings, but it doesn't fit here. 'Broad' means 'wide'. You should always say 'broad consensus'.) consensus that public panic could result in people being injured or even killed. unnecessary catastrophic chaos in society. (<-- This is too similar to your previous sentence. Try to vary the words you use. It's also awkward to say 'catastrophic chaos' - it's not something native English speakers would do.) Take the incident in Wuxi, China, (<--This needs commas around it.) as an example. In July 2014, a reporter in a local TV station reported a story about how the a (<-- There is probably more than one factory, so you shouldn't use 'the' here.) local factory has had (<-- This sentence is in reported speech, which is very similar to the past tense. You shouldn't use 'has', because that is in the present tense.) polluted the water source by pouring toxic chemicals into the river. Overnight, all the bottled water in the supermarkets was cleared out by local residents. (<-- This was a good sentence.) Some people, misled by the media and filled with fears fear, (<-- This should be singular.) even started a fight with the others (<-- You don't need this phrase.) in a shop over a bottle of water. That This (<-- Using 'that' here is a little informal.) incident led to twenty-five 25 (<--You should write numbers from one to ten in letters and 11 upwards in figures.) adults and one child being (<-- You need this word.) injured.
